Celebration of the Lord's Supper

GOD MEETS WITH US AT THE TABLE AND RENEWS US WITH THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST.

***Parents please pick up your children from Kid's Quest.**

Each week, Christ Our Hope Church welcomes all baptized Christians who are trusting in Jesus Christ for salvation, who are members in good standing of an evangelical church, and who are in proper relationship to other believers to eat the Supper. If these are not true of you, we ask you not to eat with us today. These admonitions come from God's Word (1 Corinthians 11:17-32).

At approximately 5th grade, children take a communicant's class where they learn the basics of faith in Christ and our Reformed faith. After the class ends, if parents believe a child is ready for membership, he or she is interviewed by the Elders. Upon the recommendation and approval of the Elders, the child will make a public profession of faith and be added to the rolls of the church. Only children who have been approved by the Session to take the Lord's Supper may do so. The Session asks parents to honor this practice and explain to younger children the rationale for it (also rooted in 1 Corinthians 11:17-32, esp. 11:28-31). If you have questions, please consult an elder.

SERMON QUESTIONS

FAMILY QUESTIONS:

1. What does it mean to be a good person? How was the young man in the Bible passage trying to be good? (vv 16, 20)
2. Why did Jesus switch from talking about good deeds to the “one who is good?” (v 17) How does God relate to the 2nd Table of the Law (Commandments 5-10)?
3. Jesus told the young man how to be perfect (blameless), but he went away sad. Why? How do we do the same thing? What is the only way to be perfect? (Jn 17:3)

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS:

1. What makes someone a “good person” according to our culture? According to the Bible? How is this modeled in our passage?
2. What is eternal life (Jn 17:1-3)? How should this understanding of eternal life motivate our obedience to God?
3. Why does the young man go away sorrowful? Does this mean that Jesus failed to evangelize the young man?
