*Parents please pick up your children from Kid's Quest.

Each week, Christ Our Hope Church welcomes all baptized Christians who are trusting in Jesus Christ for salvation, who are members in good standing of an evangelical church, and who are in proper relationship to other believers to eat the Supper. If these are not true of you, we ask you not to eat with us today. These admonitions come from God's Word (1 Corinthians 11:17-32).

At approximately 5th grade, children take a communicant's class where they learn the basics of faith in Christ and our Reformed faith. After the class ends, if parents believe a child is ready for membership, he or she is interviewed by the Elders. Upon the recommendation and approval of the Elders, the child will make a public profession of faith and be added to the rolls of the church. Only children who have been approved by the Session to take the Lord's Supper may do so. The Session asks parents to honor this practice and explain to younger children the rationale for it (also rooted in 1 Corinthians 11:17-32, esp. 11:28-31). If you have questions, please consult an elder.

1. The deliverance from Egypt was a watershed moment for the people of Israel, which separated one era of life from another. Are there any watershed moments in your life?

2. What did the deliverance from Egypt prove about God's character? What did it prove about his relationship with the people of Israel?

3. How does a request change based on the person who asks? Why are we more likely to fulfill the request of a friend rather than a stranger? How does that impact how you read the Ten Commandments?
